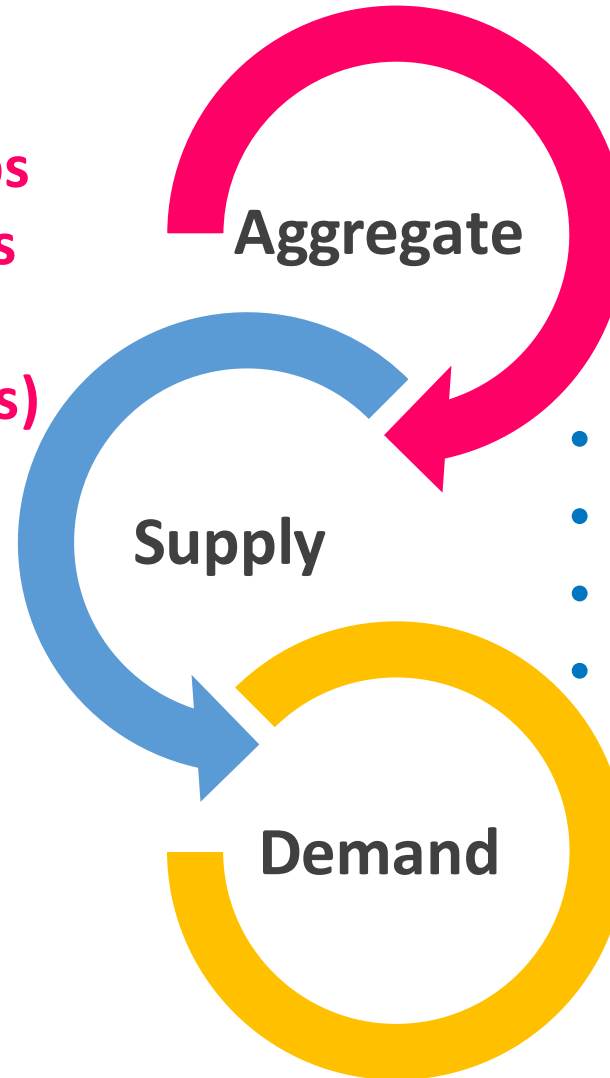
- Established in 2000
